Turning Concern into Action

This Sunday we have a **Second Collection** for the work of our local **St Vincent de Paul Society**. SVP Camberley and Frimley is very active in our local communities and has recently received lots of requests to help families and individuals. They provide help by purchasing and delivering specific items of food, clothing, white goods, bedding, and utilities. They cannot store goods and so need funds to buy items tailored to a person's need. To receive help a person or family requires a referral (usually from an agency) but if you know of someone in need, you can contact Fr. Paul or the Office to refer them to the SVP.

The St Vincent de Paul Society (England & Wales) founded in 1844, is part of an international Christian voluntary network dedicated to tackling poverty in all its forms by providing practical assistance to people in need. Their 10,000 members, motivated by faith, visit vulnerable or isolated people across England and Wales and offer them friendship and practical support.

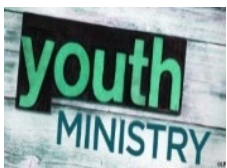
