Making disciples who encounter the saving love of Jesus Christ Growing together by being known, loved and supported Empowered by the Holy Spirit to worship, Witness, and serve

In today's Gospel, Jesus commissions his disciples to continue the work that he has begun. As Jesus was sent by God, so too does Jesus send his disciples. This continuity with Jesus' own mission is why the Church exists. Jesus grants the means to accomplish this mission when he gives his disciples the gift of the Holy Spirit. Jesus breathes in his disciples and says "Receive the Holy Spirit. For those whose sins you forgive they are forgiven; for those whose sins you retain they are retained" Forgiveness and reconciliation are gifts to us from Jesus. The source of our mission of reconciliation is the sacrament of penance in which we come to the Lord with our personal sins. St John Paul II declared the 2nd Sunday of Easter as "Divine Mercy Sunday. Christ appeared to a Polish nun, Sr. Maria Faustina Kowalska, in a series of visions that took place over almost eight years. Among those visions, Christ revealed the Divine Mercy Novena, which He asked Sister Faustina to pray for nine days, beginning on Good Friday. Part of the novena is this simple prayer that we could all say in our private time with the Lord 'Merciful Jesus, I trust in you!'

Assisted Dying Bill The legislation is heading for its Third Reading (at which the Bill passes or falls) in mid-May (delayed by the bill's sponsors perhaps in order to have more time to convince wavering MPs – suggesting that correspondence with MPs is even more important at this time). Bishop Richard has written a letter (which you can access here abdiocese.org.uk/news/), explaining why the Bill runs contrary to Catholic Social Teaching, both in its principle (we may not actively take life) and because of the inherent risks in such laws (gradual widening of criteria for eligibility beyond those expected to die in six months to other groups deemed not to have good 'quality of life', the change in relationship between medical professionals and patients, the possibility of pressure on the elderly and infirm 'not to be a burden', etc.). Please write to our MP, Dr Al Pinkerton MP at The House of Commons SW1A 0AA to express your concerns, even if you have written before.
