A few years ago, the Bishops of England and Wales gave the day of prayer for home mission a new title, **Evangelii Gaudium Sunday**. The threshold of a Jubilee Year 2025 as "Pilgrims of Hope." It is a good time to remind ourselves of what Pope Francis wrote about in Evangelii Gaudium. He wrote 'the joy of the Gospel fills the hearts and lives of all who encounter Jesus. Those who accept his offer of salvation are set free from sin, sorrow, inner emptiness and loneliness.' He goes on to say that in this exhortation he hopes to 'encourage the Christian faithful to embark upon a new chapter of evangelisation marked by this joy.'

On Evangelii Gaudium Sunday we pray for the work of evangelisation across our countries and to see ways in which Catholics within their parish settings may be more involved in this work. The Bishops' Conference also has a mission team which supports the bishops in their work to promote evangelisation activities across England and Wales. In the lead up to the Jubilee year, the team has been very busy helping the bishops to provide materials for the year of Jubilee. There is a second collection this Sunday to support the national work of evangelisation through the Home Mission Office of the Catholic Bishops of England and Wales

The readings for the 25th Sunday in Ordinary Time call us to reflect on our use of worldly resources and our responsibilities to others. They challenge us to live with honesty, justice, and faithfulness to God above all else.

- **Justice for the poor:** The first reading reminds us that God cares about the poor and condemns cheating and exploitation. We are called to treat others with fairness and care for those in need.
- **Honesty in daily life:** The Gospel warns against dishonesty and urges us to act with integrity. God sees how we handle small things, and our choices reveal our loyalty to Him.
- **Prioritizing God over wealth:** Jesus teaches that we cannot serve both God and money. We must decide where our true allegiance lies and choose what leads to eternal life.
- **Prayer for all people:** The second reading encourages us to pray for everyone, including leaders and those in authority. This reminds us that peace and order come from God's guidance and our prayers.
