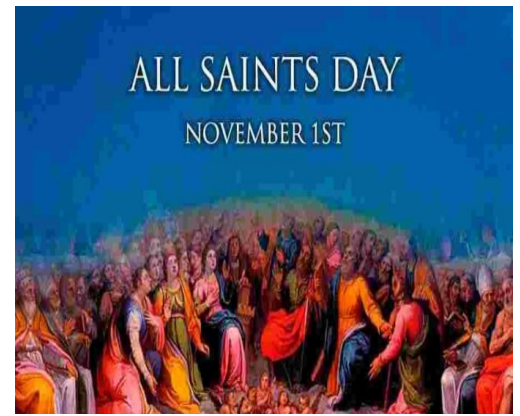

Reflection for the Solemnity of All Saints

Theme: *‘These are the ones coming out of great tribulations. They have washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb’* (Revelation 7:14).

The above theme captures who a saint is or the identity of saint, as one who despite the tribulations, trials and difficulties of life has washed and continues to wash their lives with the goodness, love, mercy and forgiveness of God to wards others and themselves. A Saint is a reflection of God’s grace in human life.

Today, we celebrate the Solemnity of All Saints, we are reminded that these saints we celebrate today struggled with human weaknesses and appetites and longings and desires. They were ordinary people who faced everyday joys, sorrows, struggles, and hopes, but they never lost sight of God’s presence in their life and Jesus’ path often articulated in the Beatitudes, which are seen as a map of Christian life.

God wants you to be a saint in those struggles or difficulties or trials or the joys, sorrows and hopes that you are experiencing at the moment. Never lose sight of God’s presence in you and Jesus’ path articulated in the Beatitudes.

During the month of November please write the names of your deceased family and friends on the “Prayers for the Dead” purple sheets that are available at the back of churches and place them in the baskets in front of the altar. The priest will say a pray for the holy souls at all masses in November
