The second collection this Sunday is for the pilgrimage **of HCPT Group 117** to Lourdes in Easter Week 2026. Every Easter, 1,000 disabled and disadvantaged children and young people enjoy a life changing pilgrimage holiday in Lourdes in the south of France. Fr Paul is the chaplain to HCPT group 117 and the second collection will help them in their fundraising.

HCPT pilgrimages are organised through a network of local groups across the UK and beyond. Each group is led by experienced volunteer Group Leaders and supported by a dedicated team of helpers, nurses, doctors, and priests. They travel together as a group and stay together in Lourdes for the week, taking part in HCPT's full programme of celebrations, fun, and prayer. Each group designs its own programme of events and activities, but there are a few things that most groups do:

- Tuesday evening Torchlight Procession: this is a wonderfully visual and emotional event. All the pilgrims in Lourdes are invited to come together for a torchlight procession, singing along, and on Tuesday night HCPT leads the procession..
- Thursday Trust Mass: over 5,000+ members of HCPT, the Irish Pilgrimage Trust, and other international groups come together in the Underground Basilica.
- Most groups have a day out, travelling by coach. A traditional and still popular destination is Gavarnie, high up in the Pyrenees. This is a spectacular venue where some days groups make snowmen and other days it's shorts and t-shirt weather! Other popular excursions include a day out at the beach (with St Jean de Luz and Biarritz being popular destinations), or going to a local zoo or other tourist attractions.

The cost of an Easter pilgrimage is approximately £1,200 per person, although this can vary slightly depending on the group and travel arrangements. This includes return travel, full board accommodation, insurance, medical support, and access to all HCPT events in Lourdes. HCPT does not expect children or young people to pay for their pilgrimage — each group fundraises to cover these costs, so that every child or young adult can travel regardless of their circumstances.
