We welcome the Rt Rev Bishop Richard Moth who will celebrate the 9.15am Mass at St Tarcisius Church. He will administer the sacraments of baptism and confirmation to Adhil Manoj & Sajin **Biswakarra**. Adhil and Sajin have been preparing for their baptism and confirmation by attending Thursday evening catechism classes. Adhil has just started his fist year at Bath University and Sajin is studying A levels at Farnborough Sixth Form. They were joined in the preparation course by their friend Youngbe who will be baptised and confirmed at the Easer Vigil.

There has been an increase in the number of people being received into the Catholic Church in our country, including young adults. Around Easter this year, the Catholic News Agency reported a decadehigh surge of new entrants to the faith. Almost all English dioceses contacted by CNA reported a significant increase in both catechumens (Adults being baptised) and candidates (adults being received). Many had not seen comparable numbers for a decade.

The Diocese of Westminster, said this year it has 252 catechumens and over 250 candidates, making a total of over 500 to be received into the Catholic Church at Easter — the most seen since 2018. The Archdiocese of Southwark, which has a significant evangelization program, saw over 450 adults complete the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) this year, more than the year before. Our own diocese of Arundel and Brighton, on the south coast, has reported it had an increase from 60 catechumens and just under 90 candidates in 2024 to 105 catechumens and 105 candidates this year.

Let us thank God for the work of the Holy Spirit in bring new believers to the Lord within the Church. Let us pray for those who taking part in our parish adult enquiry group. Let us endeavour to make our churches open to new believers and worshippers by living out our mission statement of "Making disciples who encounter the saving love of Jesus Christ - Growing together by being known, loved and supported - Empowered by the Holy Spirit to worship, witness, and serve"
